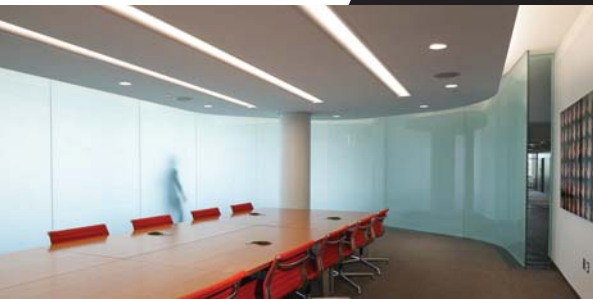

The new \$48.1 million Penn State University Henderson Building is a 93,500-square-foot, four-story facility that primarily houses the Department of Bio Behavioral Health. The building added necessary space to maximize the capacity of this important site by replacing the 'bridge' that connected Henderson Building and Henderson Building South. It provides offices for the HHD administration as well as staff and graduate students, and also provides academic spaces including a 200-seat lecture hall. With an exterior of brick and limestone, the building has been developed to complement Henderson Building, built in 1933.
